THE STANDARD U.S. SPECIFICATION COMPRISES:

JUNE 1987

SAILS & RIGGING: Mainsail and No. 1 Jib in racing sail cloth with tell tales on mainsail. Twin luff groove system. Silver anodised mast and boom, main and jib halyards in Kevlar Terylene running rigging. Halyards and slab reefing lines led aft to cockpit. Topping lift. Boom vang. Stainless steel standing rigging with twin backstay with backstay adjuster.

DECK FITTINGS: 24" stanchions with twin stainless steel PVC covered lifelines. Twin headsail tracks port and starboard with one car in each track. Stainless steel bow rail, sheet stopper. 35lb. plough anchor and stowage, 90ft. 5/16 chain. Cleats: 2 foredeck, 4 midships, 2 stern cleats. Transom step. Stainless steel stay and shroud plates. Teak coachroof handrails. Drained propane locker, with bottle stowage. Propane solenoid switch. No regulator. Four fenders. 2 x 8ft. dock lines. Navigation lights, steaming light, deck light. Manual bilge pump. 2 bulkhead compasses. Winches: 2 two speed halyard winches, type 25c. 2 two speed foresheet winches, type 27c. 2 winch handles. 2 cockpit coaming lockers. Mainsheet track and traveller. Wheel steering. Grey non-slip painted deck surface. Grey treadmaster cockpit seats. Foresheet jammers on coamings.

CABIN FITTINGS: Forecabin - Two single berths, hanging locker, washbasin. Deck hatch. Carpeted cabin sole. Curtain track. Saloon - Port and starboard single settee berths with lee cloths. Centre line table with bottle stowage and dust tray under, side lockers port and starboard. Holly and Teak cabin sole. Double berth conversion. Curtain track. Vent. 2 opening windows. Deck hatch over table. Galley - Gimballed 2 burner propane cooker with oven and broiler and crash bar. Stowage for crockery, cutlery and dry stores. Pan stowage. Twin stainless steel sinks with cold water supply from 43 US gallons stainless steel tanks. Work top with teak fiddles. Chopping board. Insulated drained ice box with shelf. Trash bin. Chart Table - With chart stowage under desk top. Pencil holder. Separate chart seat. Provision for instruments. Book rack stowage. Chart light. Wet Locker aft of chart table with drain to bilges. Heads - Marine WC with holding tank, moulded washbasin with cold supply. Opening window into bridge deck. Fixed window into cockpit. Carpeted sole. Curtain track. Lights - 2 reading lights in forecabin, 4 lights in saloon, 1 in heads, 1 over galley, 2 in aft cabin, 1 in sail locker, 1 in engine compartment. Electrics - Central 12 way switch panel with circuit breakers by chart table. Cushions - 5" berth cushions with 4" seatbacks in saloon in choice of colours.

ENGINE: Volvo 2002, 18 hp, 2 cylinder diesel in sound deadened engine compartment. Flexible mountings. 50 amp alternator. Fixed 2-bladed propeller. Water cooled exhaust. Cockpit instrument panel. Electric start. Double batteries, total capacity 204 amp/hrs. 22 US gallons fuel tank.

HULL: White hull. Fin keel. Moulded coloured trim line. Cove Line. Teak rubbing strake. Marked waterline. Bronze underwater skin fittings. Self draining cockpit. Cathodic protection.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. GENERAL.

1.1 This sales order is made and accepted subject to the conditions set forth herein. All conditions of Customer and all other conditions or warranties whatsoever are excluded from this contract or any variation thereof, unless expressly accepted by Company in writing.

1.2 There terms and conditions can only be altered or qualified by a writing signed by an officer of Company.

1.3 Commercial terms used herein (such as "Delivered Duty Paid") shall have the meanings assigned to them by the current "Incoterms" Conditions published by the International Chamber of Commerce, Paris.

1.4 If any statement or representation upon which Customer relies has been made to Customer other than in the documents enclosed with Company's quotation or acknowledgement of order, Customer must set out such statement or representation in a document to be attached to or endorsed on the order in which case Company may clarify the point and submit a new quotation.

1.5 This sales order shall become a contract binding upon the parties hereto only upon its acceptance by an officer of Company at Company's principal place of business. Such acceptance shall be evidenced by the signature of an officer of Company on the face hereof. Customer shall be sent a copy of this sales order upon its acceptance by Company.

2. DELIVERY.

2.1 Time for delivery is given as accurately as possible but is not guaranteed. Customer shall have no right to damages or to cancel the order for failure to meet any delivery time stated.

2.2 The date of delivery shall in every case be dependent upon prompt receipt of all necessary information, final instruction or approvals from Customer. Alterations by Customer in design specifications or quantities required may result in delay in delivery.

2.3 Company will endeavour to comply with reasonable requests by Customer for postponement of delivery but shall be under no obligation to do so. Where delivery is postponed otherwise than due to default by Company Customer shall pay all costs and expenses, including a charge for storage and transportation, occasioned thereby.

2.4 Unless otherwise agreed goods are sold Delivered Duty Paid to the Port designated on the face hereof.

2.5 If Customer shall refuse or fail to take delivery of the goods or fail to make default in any of the terms of this contract, Company shall have the option of either cancelling the same or reselling the goods on Customer's account. Customer being liable for any losses and costs incurred thereby.

2.6 Without prejudice to the provisions of Section 2.5 above, Company may deliver the goods in accordance with any revised instructions of Customer if compliance with such revised instructions is deemed by Company to be reasonably practical. Customer shall, however, be liable for any extra costs incurred by Company in complying with such revised instructions.

2.7 Unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing, any packaging supplied by Company is intended only to be sufficient to protect the goods for all normal conditions of transit to the Port designated on the face hereof and only for the normal period of transit to such Port. Company shall have no responsibility for packing the goods in a manner suitable for their protection during transportation from such Port to Customer's premises, or at any time thereafter.

3. TITLE.

3.1 Title to the goods or any part thereof shall pass to Customer when payment in full therefor has been made or when Company serves written notice upon Customer specifying that title to the goods or such part thereof has passed, whichever shall be the earlier in time, and Customer shall permit the servants or agents of Company to enter the Customer's premises and to repossess the goods at any time prior thereto.

3.2 Customer shall be at liberty to sell the goods purchased from Company prior to the passing of title only if prior to such sale a security agreement between Customer and Company is executed and the security interest of Company in the goods is perfected in accordance with the applicable provision of the Uniform Commercial Code, and only if such sale takes place in conformity with the terms of such agreement.

4. PRICES.

The contract price payable by Customer shall be the price specified herein together with such sum as is sufficient to cover any increase to Company after the date hereof in the cost of performance of the contract due directly or indirectly to government action, strikes, fluctuations in the costs of labour, overheads, taxation, customs duties, demurrage charges, transport charges, shipping and insurance rates, or to the imposition of surcharges on any of the three latter items or to any other similar events. Such additional sum shall become part of the agreed contract price without the necessity for prior notice or to further agreement by Customer.

5. TERMS OF PAYMENT.

5.1 Unless otherwise agreed by Company in writing the terms of payment shall be 10% of the contract price at the time this sales order is sent to Company for acceptance, with the balance due on delivery of the goods. These payment terms may be varied by a writing on the face hereof signed by an officer of Company.

5.2 All payments shall be made by bank or certified cheque or by a wire transfer of immediately available funds.

5.3 No disputes arising under this contract nor delays beyond the control of Company shall interfere with prompt payment in full by Customer.

5.4 In the event of default in payment by Customer Company shall be entitled without prejudice to any other right or remedy to suspend all further deliveries without notice and to charge interest on any amount outstanding at the highest rate permissible under applicable law.

6. SPECIFICATIONS.

Company will endeavour to manufacture the goods in accordance with the specifications in effect at the time of its acceptance of this sales order. Company reserves the right notwithstanding the above to vary such specifications without notice in the light of changes in technical knowledge, production techniques, government or other regulations, consideration for safety or other reasonable cause. The delivery of goods conforming to Company's prevailing design and specifications at the time of delivery, including those variations permitted by this Section 6, shall be good and sufficient performance of this contract by Company.

7. WARRANTY.

7.1 Company warrants that the goods to be supplied hereunder will conform to the description on the face hereof, that it will convey good title thereto, that such goods will be delivered free from any lawful security interest or other lien or encumbrance unknown to Customer, and that such goods will be free from defects in material and workmanship. COMPANY SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH IT IS INTENDED.

7.2 Company makes no warranty with respect to goods or equipment of Customer's design or supply. Company shall not be liable for any incidental or consequent damages for any breach of warranty. Company's liability and Customer's remedies are exclusively limited to the repair of equipment or materials if defective, the replacement thereof with conforming goods at the Port shown on the face of this sales order, or the repayment of the purchase price. The determination as to which of the above options is to apply will be made unilaterally by Company. Replacement of defective goods or the repayment of the purchase price will be made only upon the return of the defective goods which may be returned at the cost of Company and only after inspection by Company and receipt by Customer of definite shipping instructions from Company.

8. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

The Company shall not be liable in any circumstances in respect of death or personal injury and under no circumstances whatsoever shall Company be liable for special, indirect or consequential damages, loss of profits or damage to property arising out of or occasioned by any fault or defect in the goods supplied by Company. Customer shall fully indemnify Company from and against all such losses, damages, demands, expenses, claims, costs, actions and proceedings which are incurred by Company or threatened, demanded, brought or made against Company by any person, firm or company or governmental or other authority in respect thereof together with all costs and expenses incurred in relation thereto.

9. INSOLVENCY.

If Customer shall become bankrupt or insolvent or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or in the event of a resolution being passed or proceedings commenced for the liquidation of Customer, or if a Receiver is appointed of all or any part of Customer's assets, Company shall be entitled to cancel this contract in whole or in part by notice in writing without prejudice to any right or remedy accrued or accruing to Company.

10. FORCE MAJEURE.

Company shall not be under any liability for any delay, loss or damage caused wholly or in part by act of God, governmental restriction, condition or control, any laws, rules or regulations of the country of origin of the goods, non-arrival of imported goods, inability to obtain transport or loading facilities or by reason of any act done or not done pursuant to a trade dispute, whether such dispute involves its employees or not, or by reason of any other act, matter or thing beyond its reasonable control, including failure by the other party hereto to carry out the provisions of this contract.

11. LEGAL.

The contract shall be governed and interpreted exclusively in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement which cannot be settled amicably shall be settled exclusively and finally in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association by a single arbitrator appointed in accordance with said rules. The arbitration shall be held in New York, New York. Judgement upon the arbitrator's award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

12. TAXES.

In addition to the specified purchase price and other provisions relating to the purchase price set forth herein the customer will pay all taxes, excises, licence fees, duties, imports, and other charges (other than income taxes or taxes in the nature of an income tax) levied, assessed or imposed upon Company in the United States of America by reason of or applicable to the manufacture, sale, purchase and delivery of the products furnished hereunder, or any parts thereof. Such payment shall be made by Customer to Company at or before the time at which Company is required to pay it. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Company shall pay all taxes, excises, etc. which arise directly out of its obligation to ship the goods Delivered Duty Paid.
