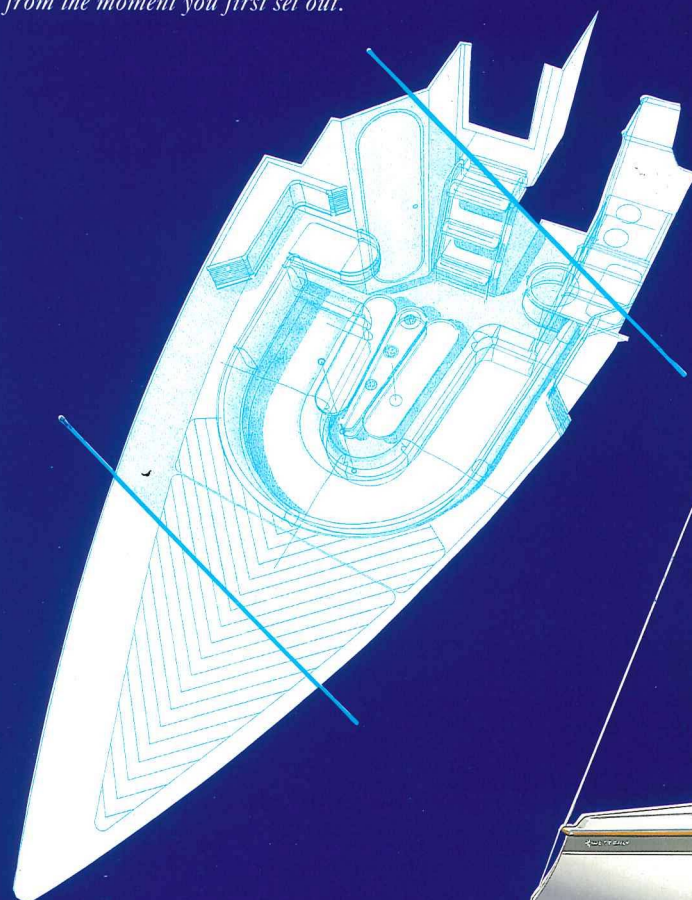
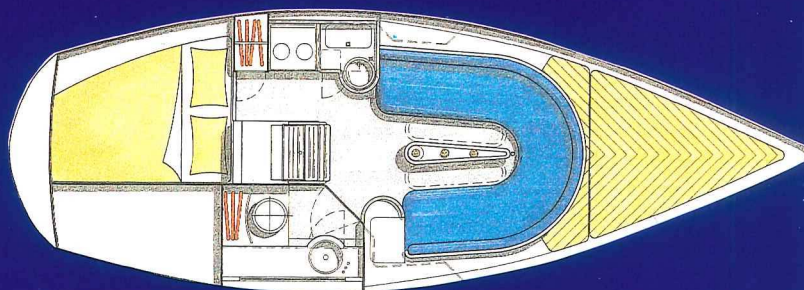

The inboard diesel saildrive unit gives effective and economical control under power, making the 260 easy to manoeuvre even in the more difficult wind and tide conditions, and her balance under both power and sail inspire confidence from the moment you first set out.



Sharing the very special quality and styling of joinery developed for the larger yachts in the Regatta range, the 260 has a spacious, open plan arrangement where even the smallest detail has been thought of; right down to the beautifully crafted louvres in Cherry wood, strategically placed to accept hi-fi speakers, and the elegant window bands in blue suede, designed to team up with the range of coordinated curtaining options. For such a compact yacht, the Regatta 260 offers a quite remarkable level of luxury accommodation, with long, comfortable berths and plenty of stowage space.
