

GRIFFON

The new 26' Westerly Griffon is the first Westerly designed by Edward Dubois. He is well known in racing circles as the designer of the Australian Admiral's Cup entry 'Police Car' and, among other successful ocean racers, the British contender 'Winsome Gold'. As you would expect with such a pedigree Griffon is a boat which will appeal to the performance minded cruising yachtsman.

A choice of fin or twin keels is offered and a hydraulically operated lifting keel will be available soon. The accommodation is for five people in two cabins with a separate marine heads and full standing headroom right through to the forecabin. The interior is built in hardwood and marine ply and there is a choice of cushion materials in fabric or vinyl.

The self-draining cockpit has two large lockers one of which is for sail stowage. The deck layout is designed for ease of handling with halyards led aft to winches alongside the mainhatch. Slab reefing is fitted as standard and all working surfaces are treated with a non-slip paint.
