

### (Any variation or addition to these Terms must be given in writing)

### PRELIMINARY

- SPECIFICATIONS All specifications are approximate only and are subject to normal margins of tolerance for the materials and construction in question. Whilst the Company will endeavour to manu-facture the Products in accordance with the specifications prevailing at the time of the Con-tract it reserves the right notwithstanding the above to vary the specifications without notice in the light of changes in technical knowledge, production techniques, Government or other regulations, consideration for safety or other reasonable cause. The delivery of Products conforming to the Company's prevailing design and specifications at the time of delivery shall be good and sufficient performance of the Contract by the Company.
- DEFECTS APPARENT ON INSPECTION
- APPARENT ON INSPECTION
   The Purchaser shall have no claim for defects apparent on visual inspection unless:




