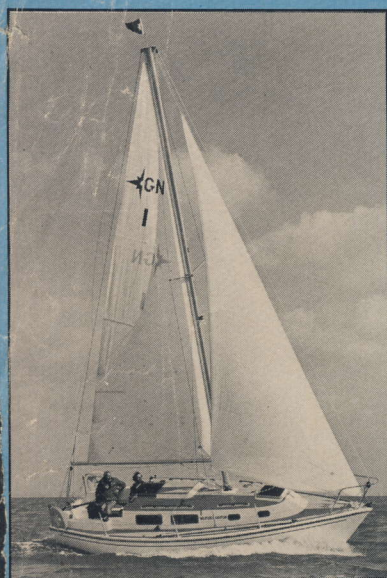


WESTERLY AT THE SOUTHAMPTON SHOW

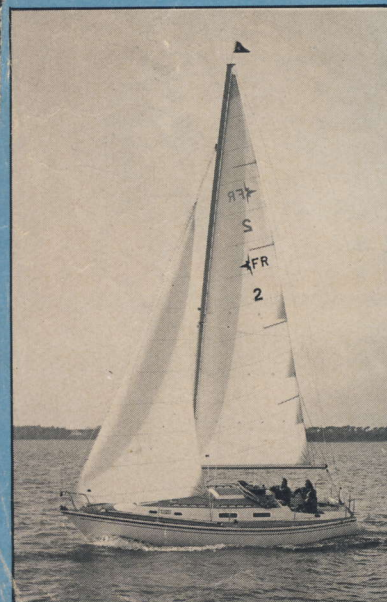

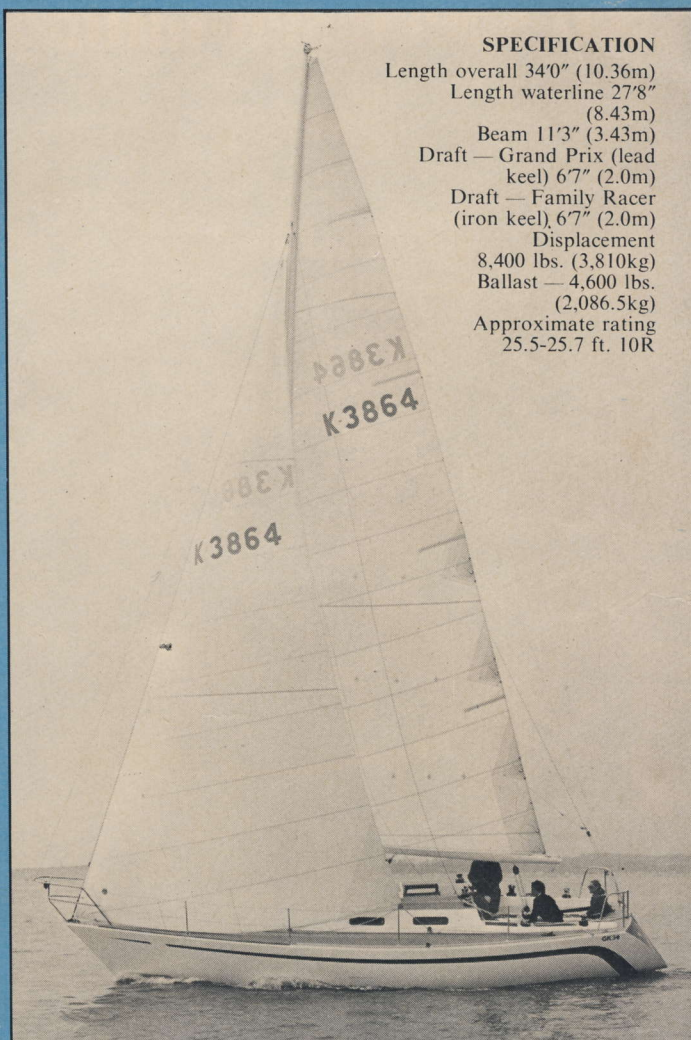
